**Nationality Classrooms** – The 26 authentically-furnished Nationality Classrooms in the University of Pittsburgh’s 42-story Cathedral of Learning provide unforgettable glimpses of European, African, Middle Eastern and Asian cultures.

**Soldiers & Sailors Museum** – Soldiers & Sailors National Military Museum & Memorial is one of the country’s largest museums dedicated to honoring & remembering our Veterans. We have exhibits that span from the Civil War to present day conflicts that tell the stories of ordinary citizens called upon to do extraordinary duties for the United States of America.

**West End Overlook** – View of the City a grand view of the Ohio River and the City from the West End Overlook and atop Mt Washington.

Lunch **Grand Concourse at Station Square** – Set in the Edwardian splendor of the Pittsburgh & Lake Erie Railroad terminal built in 1901. On the National Register of Historic Sites, it’s like no other restaurant you’ve ever seen!

1:30 – 3:30 pm **Pittsburgh History Center** – Building a Life in Western PA, 1750 to Today – This exhibit features re-creations of three period homes which provide the framework for presenting the history of the region. A log home, an immigrant worker courtyard house and a suburban ranch home. Connect with the thousands of artifacts that demonstrate home and family life, industrial development, education and religion, and immigration and ethnicity. Major events – the Great Fire of 1845, the Homestead Strike, the Salk polio vaccine – share the spotlight with compelling stories from Fort Pitt through the region’s transition from Big Steel to high tech. Changing exhibits include **“Shattering Notions”** – a magnificent display of glass and the **H.J. Heinz Company** – This exhibit relates the story of the Heinz Company’s 130 years in business, from its first product, homemade horseradish, to its current status as a multi-national conglomerate.
